

## Report on the meeting of the Mayor with the municipal directors Municipal government commences the year with the announcement of ten tenders

## 16 January 2013, Prizren

EC Ma Ndryshe, within the "Online Transparency of Prizren Municipality" project, during this week has partaken in the following meeting of the mayor, Mr. Ramadan Muja, with municipal directors, in which a number of decisions were rendered.

Prizren municipal government, in its opening meeting for 2013 has approved numerous decisions largely related to allowing the announcement of invitations to tender for carrying out various works in education facilities, for supply with the equipment and other services, as well as on particular requests of relevant departments.

The largest number of the announcements of invitations to tender has received the Municipal Department of Education and Science (*hereinafter MDES*), which has been granted with the consent for proceedings on seven tenders, while one of their proposals has been refused. At the request of MDES, the local executive has approved the announcement of invitations to tender for: the repair and regulation of the yard of Primary/Secondary Low School (PSLS) "Luigj Gurakuqi" in Nashec village (estimated 20,000 EUR); renovation of the roof of PSLS "Shtjefën Gjeçovi" in Zym village (estimated 10,000 EUR); renovation of roof of PSLS "Heronjtë e Lumës" in Shkozë village (estimated 10,000 EUR); re-installing of central heating system in PSLS "Fadil Hisari" in Prizren, a project which according to MDES' clarification was not implemented although it has been planned for several years (estimated 50,000 EUR); replacement of the roof and sanitary nodes in PSLS "Motrat Qiriazi" in Prizren (estimated 50,000 EUR); construction of the perimeter fence around the PSLS "Deshmoret e Hasit" schoolyard in Kabash village of Has region (estimated 40,000 EUR); replacement of doors and windows in PSLS "Sezai Surroi" in Korishë village (estimated 45,000 EUR). The request of MDES for drafting of other school projects has not been approved.

Local government has adopted the proposal of the Department of Public Services for allowing the announcement for invitation to tender for drafting of the project for classifying traffic signs in the municipality of Prizren.

Prizren executive has also agreed with the proposal of the Department of Administration and allowed the announcement of invitation to tender for building the statue of Ismail Kryeziu in the Memorial Complex in Arbana, same as the proposal for the supply with computer software equipment for the needs of local administration.

At this meeting was also been approved the request of the Political Prisoners Association – Prizren branch, for financial support on annual basis. This session has also passed the request of the Department of Culture, Youth and Sports for material support for organization of the ceremony for the announcement of the most distinguished in the field of sports and culture.

The municipal government has approved also the proposal coming from the Department of Labour and Social Welfare for allowing the distribution of firewood, which have remained unclaimed by some KLA war invalids, and the same be given to some poverty-stricken households.

The project of EC Ma Ndryshe for transparency monitoring of executive branch shall continue on publicizing monitoring findings through regular press releases and project's website where the findings are posted directly from the monitoring staff. By now, all the monitoring findings, including regular press releases and other information relative to local government of Prizren, are published on regular basis on the project's website: www.online-transparency.org.
