

Notice on the meeting of the Mayor with directors of Municipality
The municipality renders a decision for the recruitment of 20 fixed-term employees

19 June 2012, Prizren

Proceeding from the “Online Transparency of Prizren Municipality” project, EC Ma Ndryshe has partaken at the meeting of the Mayor, Mr. Ramadan Muja, with the municipal directors, in which a number of decisions were rendered.

At the request of the Department of Administration the local executive has rendered the decision for allowing the recruitment of twenty fixed-term clerks/employees for performing specific duties in Prizren Municipality upon the request of several directorates due to the lack of human resources for performing duties and responsibilities at work. The decision has been taken given the summer season and the influx of the citizens, for which local government has justified that this initiative would enable service delivery without delay, but also for the fulfilment of legal obligations for the approval of annual leaves to permanent employees. The monthly gross salary for seasonal employees amounts to 150 EUR.

Upon the request of the Jewish Community of Kosova to the Department of Property and Legal Affairs of the Directorate of Administration, the board has taken the decision for leasing two offices for the needs of this Association, in the premises of former ‘Mbrotjtja Popullore’ building (*National Defence*).

At this meeting, the municipal government has approved the request of the Directorate of Public Services for allowing the announcement of the tender for clearance of Muslim, Roman Catholic and Eastern Orthodox cemeteries in Prizren, for which the allocation of funds is made from the category of Goods and Services of the municipal budget.

At the same time the Directorate of Culture, Youth and Sports has been granted with financial support for the marking of the “26 June – International Day Against drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking”, a project foreseen as the fourth component of youth policies.

Local executive has supported the official travel for two (2) municipal officials from the Directorate of Administration to Durrës (Albania) for the upcoming meeting of the group for the identification of the requirements for training, as well as the official travel for two municipal civil servants in Niš/Nish (Serbia) for participation in the “Networking for Local Sustainable Development” project of the European Commission.

In addition, the request of the NGO EC Ma Ndryshe, an organisation monitoring the municipal executive, has been approved in relation to the participation at the regular meetings of the mayor Muja with the advisory board also after the expiration of the Memorandum of Understanding, by which the monitoring staff shall oversee the board’s meetings only, being excluded from the pre-board’s meetings.

EC Ma Ndryshe’s project for transparency monitoring of the executive branch shall continue on publicizing monitoring findings through regular press releases and project’s website where the findings are posted directly from the monitoring staff. By now, all the monitoring findings, including regular press releases and other information relative to local government of Prizren, are published regularly on the

project's website: www.online-transparency.org.
